RULES OF THE GAME

1. There is a drop dead time limit of one hour per game.
 - A. Saturday's games are drop dead. **No exceptions.** Other games are scheduled after your game.
 - B. During the week. **Before the game begins both coaches** will need to decide if they want to complete the inning they are in, which might run you past the one hour limit, or to adhere to the drop dead limit.
2. You will have a continuous batting order per game.
 - A. Rotate the batting order from game to game. This way every player gets the chance to be the leadoff batter and the last batter.
 - B. Single base hit, until the last batter. The last batter will round the bases.
 - C. No outs are recorded but do try to get the out.
3. No umpires
 - A. No outs are kept, so no umpires.
 - B. No parents as umpires for same reason.
 - C. To help players stay focused, you may have as many parents on the field as you would like. Make sure they stay out of the way of the ball and player.
4. Bases
 - A. Home team - puts on the field
 - B. Visiting team - puts away - only if there are no games following your game.
 - C. Bases will be put in the green box behind Tibbals field.
